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#### NARRATIVE REPORT

I have been a member of the full time academic faculty in the Division of General at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center (formerly Beth Israel Hospital) since 1987. My principal contributions are 1) a primary care internal medicine practice, 2) the teaching of medical students, residents and senior physicians, 3) leadership in continuing medical education, 4) national leadership and guideline development in the field of perioperative medicine, and 5) the publication of scholarly articles and textbooks on topics that include perioperative medicine, headache, and evidence based history taking.

I am a staff physician in Healthcare Associates, the hospital based primary care internal medicine practice at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center. I care for a panel of patients that is weighted towards those with multiple chronic illnesses and high disease complexity. In a national survey, physician peers have repeatedly selected me as one of the best primary care physicians in America. In 1987, I developed the first general medicine consultation service at Beth Israel Hospital. This experience encouraged me to expand my expertise and reach in perioperative medicine to broader national audiences.

One of my core missions and contributions is the education of physicians and other primary care clinicians on local, national, and international scales. I achieve this through leadership in continuing medical education, guideline development, and publication of articles in textbooks and the peer reviewed literature that provide summary guidance on clinical topics and improve clinical care. Approximately one third of my professional time is devoted to teaching. I am an advisor and clinical preceptor to internal medicine residents in the ambulatory setting. In 1992, I was selected as the Herrman L. Blumgart associate firm chief in the Department of Medicine; a position which I held for 10 years. While in this role, I received an award from the medical housestaff at Beth Israel Hospital as the outstanding teacher and advisor in the training program.

I have developed and direct the Picker Fellowship in Evidence Based Medicine, a new fellowship to train junior general medicine faculty in the methodology of systematic reviews. However, in addition to mentoring medical residents and junior faculty in our division, many of my formally supervised trainees, in contrast to the traditional mentor/trainee relationship for clinical investigators, are "virtual" and include physicians around the country and globally who learn from my direct teaching roles and from my writing.

For example, I have an active role in continuing medical education. I speak widely at invited grand round settings and large scale CME lectures to audiences of as many as 4000 clinicians. I regularly receive scores of > 3.6 out of 4.0 from conference participants. Major topics include preoperative medical evaluation and risk reduction, evaluation of headache, new drugs for primary care, primary care management of depression, and evidence based treatment of hypertension. I lecture two to three dozen times each year across the country and provide direct face to face education for approximately 20,000 clinicians annually. I lecture regularly to diverse medical audiences including internists, family physicians, hospitalists, anesthesiologists, surgeons, pulmonologists, and nurse practitioners.

I also have important leadership roles in continuing education. I am the course director for a Harvard sponsored CME course, Prevention in Primary Care Practice, and directed an international CME program in

Switzerland for Harvard Medical International. For four years, I conceived of and directed a novel collaborative CME program for physicians in Vietnam that was sponsored by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). For seven years, I was an associate course director for Current Clinical Issues in Primary Care, a series of large scale primary care CME programs sponsored by Harvard Medical School and collaborating institutions in seven cities across the country each year. I am a member of the core teaching faculty for the American College of Physicians (ACP). This role has included speaking at ACP annual sessions and teaching venues, editorial development of online teaching modules, and publication of clinical updates in the *Annals of Internal Medicine*.

My written communications aim to change clinical practice and improve quality of care; the focus is on preoperative medical evaluation, headache, and evidence based clinical evaluation. I have written more than six dozen chapters, narrative, and systematic reviews for the peer-reviewed medical literature in these areas. I have co-edited two textbooks on medical consultation and a widely read textbook in the *Lange* series on evidence based history taking that is aimed towards medical students. For 5 years, I was a deputy editor at *JGIM*, the *Journal of General Internal Medicine*, where I was responsible for manuscript review and editorial decisions. I am currently a section editor for the Beyond the Guidelines series in the *Annals of Internal Medicine*. I co-edited a methods manual for the optimal conduct of systematic reviews of medical tests for the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ).

I authored an American College of Physicians (ACP) guideline for the estimation and reduction of risk of perioperative pulmonary complications. This guideline was the first published summary of this literature, has changed clinical practice, and provides the basis for a national standard of care in the field. The guideline manuscripts in the *Annals of Internal Medicine*, and an earlier summary of the literature in the *New England Journal of Medicine*, have since been cited more than 630 times by other authors writing in the field. A paper in *JAMA*, that provides guidance on clinical evaluation of patients suspected of having temporal arteritis, combined my interests in headache and evidence based history taking, and has since been cited more than 165 times.

I have represented the American College of Physicians on several national panels charged with developing quality of care standards. One important product of this role was a national position statement on performance measures for the primary prevention of cardiovascular disease in primary care settings. This was a collaborative work product with the American College of Cardiology and the American Heart Association. I have been a member of the governing board of the Society of Perioperative Assessment and Quality Improvement, an international multidisciplinary organization.

In 2013, I was promoted to Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School. I have become a nationally recognized educator and leader in the fields of perioperative medicine and evidence based clinical evaluation through guideline development, scholarly publications, and invitations to speak from academic institutions and societies. In recognition of these activities, I received a National Award for Scholarship in Medical Education from SGIM for scholarship in clinical practice. In 2016, I was elevated to Master of the American College of Physicians (MACP), an honor reserved for select leaders in the ACP who have demonstrated "integrity, positions of honor, eminence in practice or in medical research, or other attainments in science or in the art of medicine."
