The online course provides knowledge and training that prepares professionals for the one-day classroom CPO Certification® Fusion™ class. Mr. Deyo has been with EcoLab for 29 years and has certified more than 1,000 pool operators with the CPO® certification.

Since 1982, Mr. Freligh has been teaching and certifying pool professionals through the Certified Pool/Spa Operator® (CPO®) certification program. As of May 31, 2014, he has certified nearly 10,000 professionals.

Trevor Sherwood, Pool Operation Management, Brick, New Jersey accepted two awards. The organization was recognized as NSPF Instructor Team of the Year. This newly created award recognizes the educational efforts of the entire team of 13 instructors. Mr. Sherwood was also recognized for having Certified the Most Individuals in the Past Year. Pool Operation Management was founded in 1980. The organization as a whole has certified over 8,000 pool professionals with the CPO® certification program. They are eager to share their knowledge and experiences to help others in the industry.

Quebec, Canada, was recognized with an award for his dedication to pool operator training, having Certified the Most Individuals Outside the U.S. in the past year, through the CPO® certification program. Mr. Lajoie has been an NSPF Instructor since 1997.
