Dr. Murphy's diverse experience and significant expertise in the fields of addiction medicine and pain management make him uniquely qualified to serve as a member of the Task Force. We believe his perspective will be an invaluable addition as the Task Force considers educating healthcare providers on how to help patients suffering from pain and discussing strategies that may prevent or mitigate the acute pain.

Dr. Murphy has experience working in a variety of clinical environments and treating patients with many different pain and addiction needs. Moreover, he has the rare distinction of being triple certified in Anesthesiology, Pain Medicine, and Addiction Medicine.

Dr. Murphy is also a committed clinician educator and community leader on issues related to pain management, safe prescribing, and addiction. He has authored and delivered presentations throughout Kentucky that are approved by the Kentucky Board of Medical Licensure as satisfying the statutory and mandatory licensure requirements for CME regarding pain management with controlled substances, and he created and chaired the "Optimal Prescribing Is Our Inherent Duty" (OPIOID) comprehensive physician prescribing seminar for the Greater Louisville Medical Society.
